# Gassan Climbing Course Guide

## 月山山頂への道

Mt. Gassan's climbing period starts from July 1st and ends in mid-September (undetermined date, depends on the beginning of the snowing period each year).

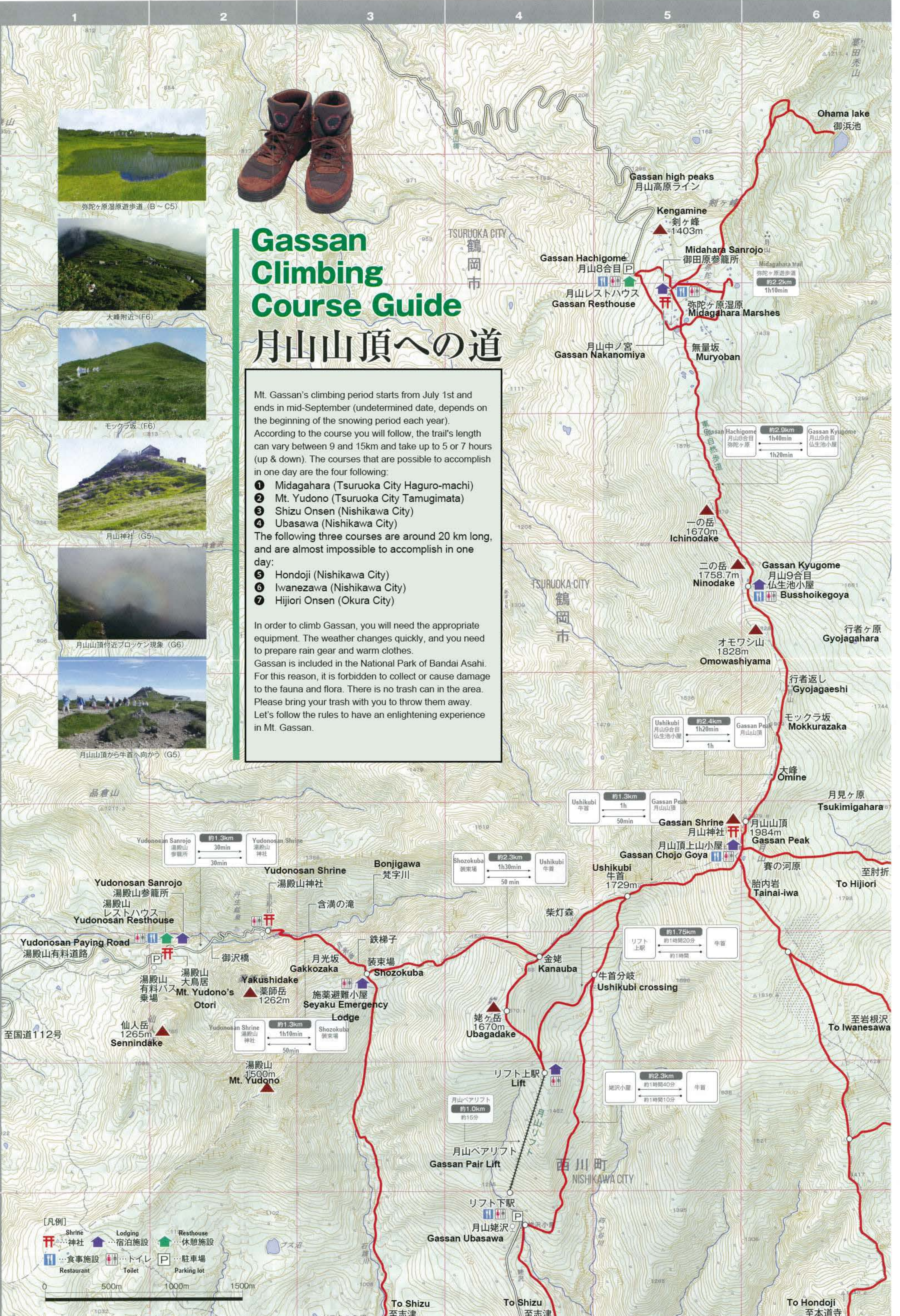
According to the course you will follow, the trail's length can vary between 9 and 15km and take up to 5 or 7 hours (up & down). The courses that are possible to accomplish in one day are the four following:

- ① Midagahara (Tsuruoka City Haguro-machi)
- ② Mt. Yudono (Tsuruoka City Tamugimata)
- ③ Shizu Onsen (Nishikawa City)
- ④ Ubasawa (Nishikawa City)

The following three courses are around 20 km long, and are almost impossible to accomplish in one day:

- ⑤ Hondoji (Nishikawa City)
- ⑥ Iwanezawa (Nishikawa City)
- ⑦ Hijiori Onsen (Okura City)

In order to climb Gassan, you will need the appropriate equipment. The weather changes quickly, and you need to prepare rain gear and warm clothes. Gassan is included in the National Park of Bandai Asahi. For this reason, it is forbidden to collect or cause damage to the fauna and flora. There is no trash can in the area. Please bring your trash with you to throw them away. Let's follow the rules to have an enlightening experience in Mt. Gassan.
